



About Anglim Winery: Anglim winery is a small, family-owned label focused on producing Rhône varietals and blends, including Syrah, Grenache, Viognier, and Roussanne, with grapes from some of the finest growers in California. Recent additions to the portfolio also include Cabernet, Zinfandel and Pinot Noir. Winemaker Steve Anglim realizes that stellar wines begin in the vineyard, and is passionate about sourcing the finest fruit for Anglim wines, seeking out growers both large and small in unique microclimates. Our limited case production of 4000 cases per year allows us to handcraft our wines in small lots with a combination of tradition and innovation. Many of our wines are single vineyard bottlings, allowing our customers to experience the unique characteristics of each vineyard from year to year. Anglim uses 100% French oak barrels from a variety of top coopers, and manages the winemaking approach and new oak percentages to create wines with a balanced style, and enough character to be cellared but enough elegance to be enjoyed now.

About Steve and Steffanie Anglim: The Anglims got into the wine business rather innocently Starting out as home winemakers. "After my first effort, my wife wondered what I could do with some real wine grapes, so I starting making one-ton lots in our garage and taking classes at U.C. Davis," said Anglim. Eventually, the hobby turned into much more than that and the Anglims began sourcing high quality fruit for what would eventually become their family winery.

Steve left his job in finance to work full-time as the winemaker and head of operations. Steffanie has been a management consultant in Los Angeles since 1995, providing strategy and transformation services to Fortune 50 clients worldwide; she also assists with winery sales and marketing activities.
