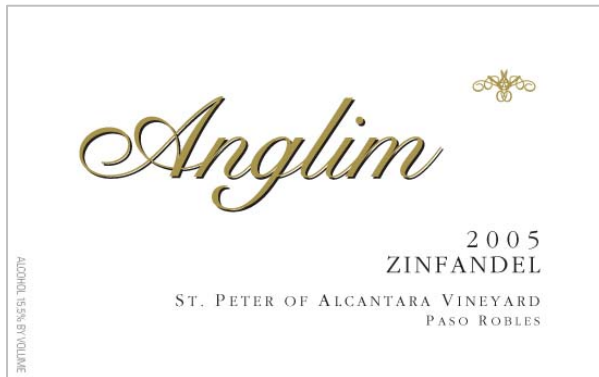




2005 ZINFANDEL – ST. PETER OF ALCANTARA VINEYARD

WINEMAKING

- De-stemmed and fermented whole-berry in open-top bins using slow-fermenting yeast strain
- Extended passed dryness, then pressed/racked directly to barrel
- Aged 20 months in barrel (80% French oak, 20% American oak, approximately 20% new overall)
- Bottled unfinned and unfiltered

NOTES

From a small vineyard on the west side near Templeton, this Paso Robles Zinfandel is rich and lively, showing bright plum, crushed berries, and cinnamon-spice. Well-balanced and food-friendly.
