GRAPE VARIETY: 80% Grenache, 20% Syrah

VINEYARD: Cass Vineyard, Paso Robles

Plus various Paso Robles for Syrah

BOTTLING DATE: June 25, 2007

ALCOHOL: 15.1%

RELEASE DATE: October 1, 2007

WINEMAKING

- Crushed 80% whole berries into open-top fermenters
- Cold soak followed by ten-day fermentation
- Pressed to barrels dirty, and barrel aged 20 months in 100% French oak (approximately 20% new)

NOTES

Medium-bodied, ruby-red Grenache, with flavors of bright berry, plum, cola, and a hint of smoke. Easily paired with a variety of foods, from backyard BBQ to pasta dishes.
