WINEMAKING

- Predominantly whole berries fermented in open-top bins for extended period
- Pressed to barrel dirty, and aged 26 months in mostly neutral French oak to retain fruit character

NOTES

Our first Cabernet Sauvignon, from a small west-side vineyard in the Adelaida Hills area, spiked with a bit of Syrah. The wine has flavors and aromas of cherry, pomegranate, dried mushroom, with a touch of licorice on the finish, and will be a nice compliment to a variety of meat dishes.
