WINEMAKING

- Crushed 80% whole berries into open-top fermenters
- Cold soaked for 3 days followed by ten-day fermentation
- Pressed to barrels dirty, and barrel aged 20 months in French oak

NOTES

A lush Grenache, with flavors of ripe strawberry, plum, and spice, and framed by good structure and fine tannins. Easily paired with a variety of foods, from backyard BBQ to pasta dishes.
