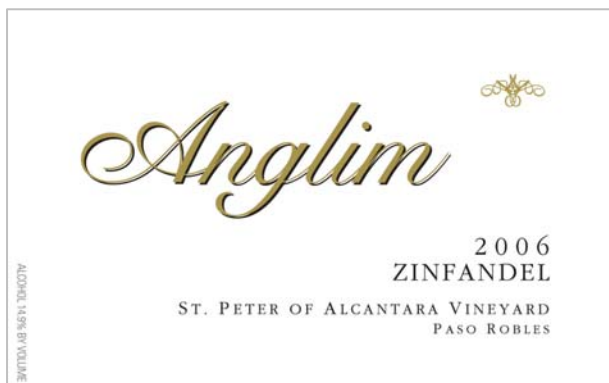




## 2006 ZINFANDEL – ST. PETER OF ALCANTARA VINEYARD



**GRAPE VARIETY:** 100% Zinfandel  
**VINEYARD:** St. Peter of Alcantara, Paso Robles  
**BOTTLING DATE:** March 14, 2008  
**ALCOHOL:** 14.9%

**PRODUCTION:** 222 cases  
**RELEASE DATE:** July 15, 2008

### WINEMAKING

- De-stemmed and fermented whole-berry in open-top bins using slow-fermenting yeast strain
- Extended passed dryness, then pressed/racked directly to barrel
- Aged 17 months in barrel (100% French oak, single-use and neutral)
- Bottled unfinned and unfiltered

### NOTES

From a small vineyard on the west side near Templeton, this Zinfandel is rich and savory, showing smoky black plum, raspberry, and currant, with a hint of roasted nuts on the finish. Complex and evolving.

Drink now through 2011.
